

- A linear equation is an equality involving variables. It says that the value of the expression on one side of the equality sign is equal to the value of the expression on the other side.
- A linear equation may have a rational number, an integer or a whole number for its solution.
- Just as numbers, variables can also be transposed from one side of the equation to the other.
- The utility of linear equations in their diverse applications is; different problems on numbers, ages, perimeters, combination of currency notes, and so on.
