

- A circle graph or a pie chart shows the relationship between a whole and its parts.
- Outcomes of an event or experiment are equally likely to be the same if each has the same possibility of occurring.
- Probability of an event $\text{Number of favourable outcomes} \div \text{Total Number of outcomes}$
- Probability of an event can have a value from 0 to 1
- Probability of an impossible event is 0.
