

1. Variable: Symbol which takes on various numerical values. E.g. a, b, c
2. Equation: a statement of equality in which one or more variable are involved.
3. Algebraic Expression: an expression containing a variable and a constant. E.g. $2x - 5$
4. Like terms: terms having same variable. $2x, 5x, 8x$.
5. Unlike terms: terms having different variable. E.g. $2y, 3x, 2z$
